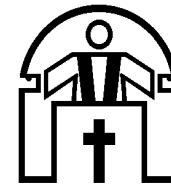

"Guardrails & Tattletales"

One of the most interesting and troubled churches in the Bible was the church in the city of Corinth. As we read Paul's two letters addressed to them, we get a sense of the tension and the trouble they experienced. These two letters comprise 12% of the entire New Testament. That's a significant volume of material.

One of the problems they faced seemed to be petty arguments and disagreements among the members. The city of Corinth was quite possibly an easy breeding ground for the kind of dissension the church experienced. The church members were simply a reflection of the society around them.

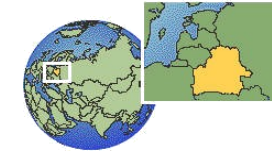
I think there are some interesting lessons that can be learned from this troubled church. Read I Corinthians 1:10-18 where we find Paul addressing some of the issues in his initial thoughts to them. Odd as it may sound, I think there are lessons here about "Guardrails & Tattletales."

International Mission Trip

Belarus Mission Trip

We had our second informational meeting this past Tuesday to provide more details regarding the possibility of a summer mission trip to Belarus. Our special guest was Nikolay Kulikovich who is a native of Brest, Belarus and would be accompanying us on the trip.

We are looking at a trip of about 12-14 days in early June. The cost will be approximately \$2,200 with, hopefully, almost 50% of that cost being offset through a variety of fund-raisers, contributions and mission funds available.

Our housing would be in a Christian camp near Minsk, the capital of Belarus. There would be 2-3 to a room. Buses or vans will be arranged for our travel to worksites and sightseeing.

One logical question that is asked regarding such a venture is, "Why Belarus?" When Nikolay was asked the question, he responded by telling us that it is primarily to build relationships with Christians in a different part of the world as a display of our unity as brothers and sisters in Christ. There are tremendous needs in Belarus and our presence will be greatly appreciated by the people.

If you are interested in participating but weren't able to be present at the meeting, call the church office to let us know. We'll be providing regular updates in the newsletter regarding our progress.

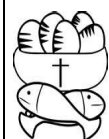
Game Night
