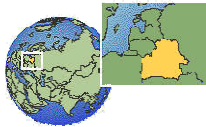

## Belarus Mission Trip News

The first exciting steps have already been taken as we prepare for our journey to Belarus.

The purpose of the mission trip is to build a relationship with the church in Belarus, to assist in the building of the physical church, to mentor the children, and to model English language skills.

The dates for the mission trip aren't set, but the plan is to go in June. It's not too late to decide to participate. The first requirement for those going to Belarus is a valid passport. If you don't already have one, apply for a passport NOW. Entry into Belarus requires a separate Visa which can only be obtained with a valid passport, and all of this official business takes time. Contact the church office for more information on the trip.

Even if you don't plan to go to Belarus, you can still be a vital part of this mission. We ask that you pray for those who will undertake this trip, the planning of this mission, and for our brothers and sisters in Belarus. "Pray for us." (Hebrews 13:18)

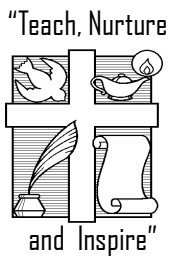
## Parish Nurse

Dear Church Family,

Wow! This has been some kinda winter, huh? Just a brief reminder...it's flu season, and this year, it seems it's gone viral. (OK, bad pun.) Indiana is having a very strong outbreak of influenza right now, and it is not only H1N1, but other strains of flu. If you haven't gotten your flu shot yet, do it now. And remember to use good sense to help avoid catching it, and/or spreading it. Good handwashing, covering coughs and sneezes, sleep, exercise and good nutrition all help. And if you get it, don't go to work or school. Do go to the doctor if it gets severe, and remember, there are antiviral medications that can reduce the severity and length of the flu, but you have to start taking them within 24 hours of the first symptoms.

Also, so far I have only had 2 responses to a CPR class. If you are interested, please let me know. I need to have at least 8 people for a class.

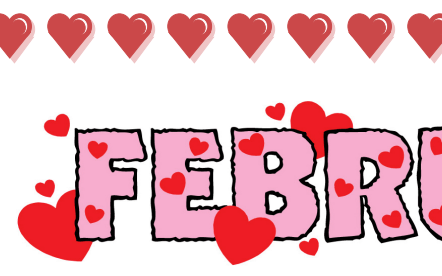
