“A Model or a Mirror?”

The most well-known sermon ever preached – by a landslide – is the Sermon on the Mount. It’s found in Matthew’s gospel and is the introduction to the ministry of Jesus. In fact, if one was unfamiliar with the Bible and reading it for the first time, it’s the Sermon on the Mount that would first be encountered as an introduction to Jesus and what he taught.

Imagine what that would be like. What if you knew nothing about Christianity and picked up a Bible and read through the entire Old Testament and then opened the New Testament and soon found yourself reading the Sermon on the Mount? What astonishing things Jesus said to his followers! What words of affirmation and challenge!

Read Matthew 5:13-20 where Jesus provides both the affirmation and the challenge. The words found in those verses might move you to wonder what you represent to those around you – “A Model or a Mirror?”

Making a Difference at The Diner!

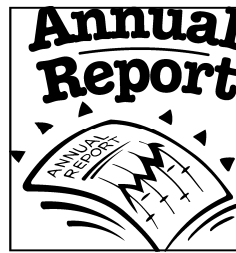
That's what you want, isn't it? You want to make a difference in the world and in someone's life. You long for that opportunity, don't you?
